


Type: Shrub

Where to find: Utsodhaara Teesta Township

Blooming Season: Summer to Fall (and beyond)

Native to Brazil, the Purple Allamanda dazzles with trumpet-shaped flowers in hues ranging from pinkish-purple to violet. These ornamental shrubs are often seen climbing trellises and pergolas across our courtyards. Blooming in succession for months, they bring both structure and softness to outdoor architecture, adding bursts of regal colour to summer days.

Where to find: Taj Guras Kutir

Blooming Season: Early to Mid Spring

Revered in Himalayan folklore and stamped in Indian philately, the Guras blooms with bold clusters of crimson flowers. This evergreen rhododendron prefers moist, humus-rich soil and lends more than beauty — its blossoms have been traditionally used for heart health, detox, and reducing inflammation. You'll often find them tucked into our hill-facing properties, a nod to their mountainous origin.




Gold-tipped Bottlebrush (Callistemon polandii)

Where to find: Taj Chia Kutir

Blooming Season: Late Winter to Summer

A hardy coastal shrub with striking red, spiky flowers, the Gold-tipped Bottlebrush looks like a firework frozen in bloom. Apart from its ornamental allure, it serves a practical purpose too — as a windbreak hedge or a natural screen. You'll find it lining walkways and entry



points, offering both privacy and pollinator delight.



Silver Trumpet Tree (Tabebuia argentea)

Where to find: Raichak on Ganges

Blooming Season: February to April

This sun-loving tree from the Caribbean lights up dry seasons with dazzling yellow trumpet-shaped flowers. Its upright form and minimal water needs make it a sculptural presence in our urban gardens and boulevards. Often seen as a harbinger of spring, it invites birds, bees, and admirers alike with its flamboyant display.

Where to find: Vanya Awas

Blooming Season: January to March

This towering tropical tree is impossible to ignore. Before leafing out in spring, the Shimul/Semul erupts into flame-red blossoms, creating a surreal forest canopy. The soft cotton inside its fruit — called kopak — has long been used to stuff pillows, sofas, and even as material in plywood and matchbox manufacturing. In our sylvan properties, it stands tall — reminding us of nature's utility and splendour.

Blue Passionflower (Passiflora caerulea)

Where to find: Taj Taal Kutir

Blooming Season: July to December

An exotic vine native to South America, the Blue Passionflower weaves across railings and garden walls with hypnotic, starburst blooms. These aren't just ornamental — the fruit aids digestion, and traditional remedies use the roots and leaves to treat inflammation and gut infections. A conversation starter in every sense.






African Tulip Tree or Rudra Palash (Spathodea campanulata)

Where to find: Ecospace Business Park

Blooming Season: Spring & Summer

Like a trumpet heralding joy, Rudra Palash or the African Tulip unfurls fiery blooms of reddish-orange, crowning green canopies with flamboyance. Fast-growing and hardy, it thrives in tropical climates and creates spectacular floral carpets below its canopy. A favourite of photographers and pollinators alike, its silhouette is one of the most memorable in our landscapes.

Where to find: Palm Cove, Raichak


Blooming Season: November to February

As we look ahead, we remain inspired by the collective strength of these relationships—the foundation upon which we continue to grow.



Sustainable Livelihood Support:

In the remote island village of Rakkhashkhali, where the river meets the Bay of Bengal and city life feels like a distant dream, our CSR initiative brought a ray of hope to 40 marginalised families battling harsh natural conditions and economic instability.

Our programme — in collaboration with NGO Our Association of Remedy (OAR) — identified families in Khetra Mohanpur village in need of sustainable support. Twenty families were trained in vermicomposting, while the remaining 20 received hands-on guidance in poultry rearing. Each household was equipped with the infrastructure to kick-start their enterprise — from vermincompost pits to poultry shelters. High-yielding chicks were distributed, and training focused on disease control, feeding, organic practices, waste management, and commercial viability.

Two months on, the villagers are showing remarkable ownership and commitment. The compost pits are thriving, the chicks are growing, and with continued handholding by OAR, the seeds of resilience, circular economy, and sustainable farming are taking strong root.

This initiative isn't just about livelihood — it's about restoring dignity, enabling self-reliance, and nurturing a more hopeful future.


