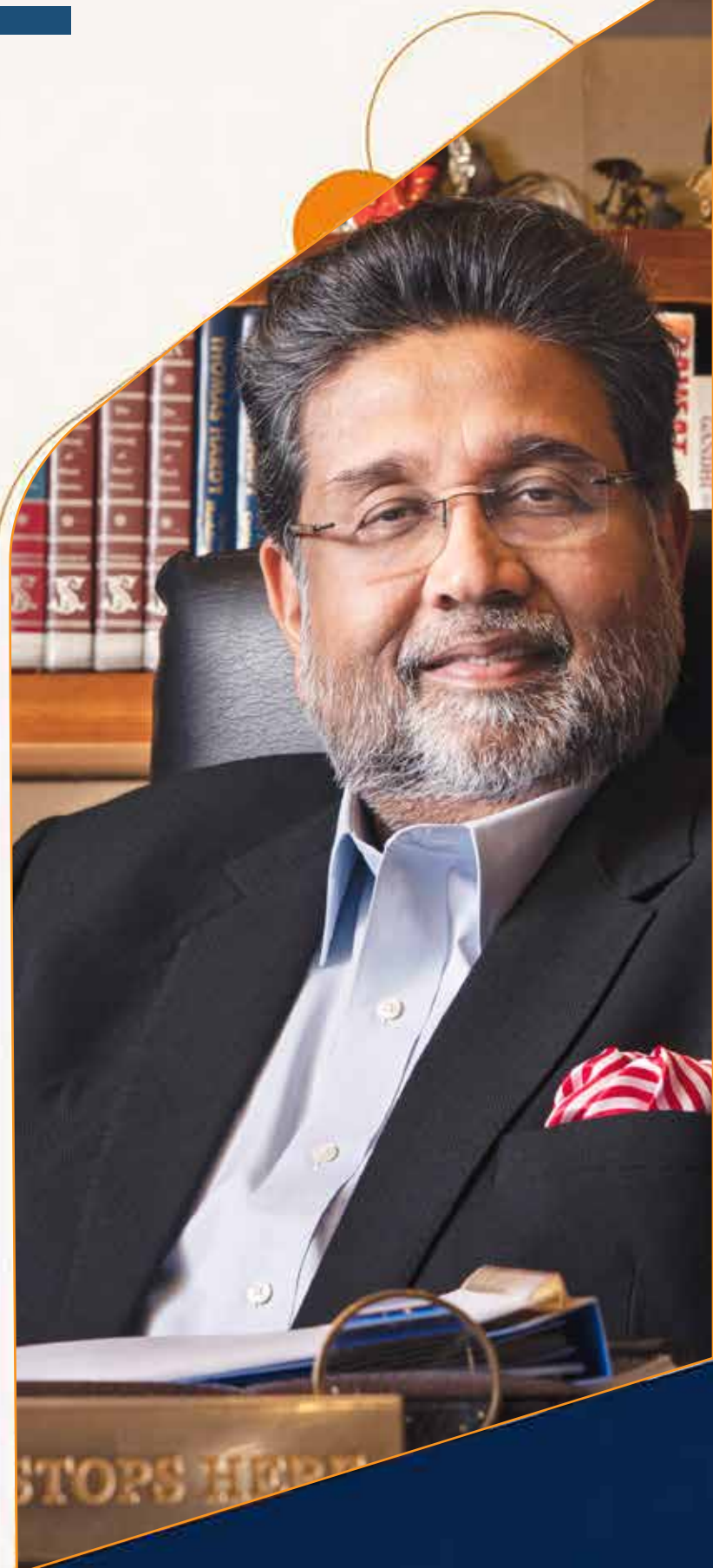
As we celebrated Independence Day this month, I am reminded that the privilege of being free also comes with the responsibility to use that freedom well.

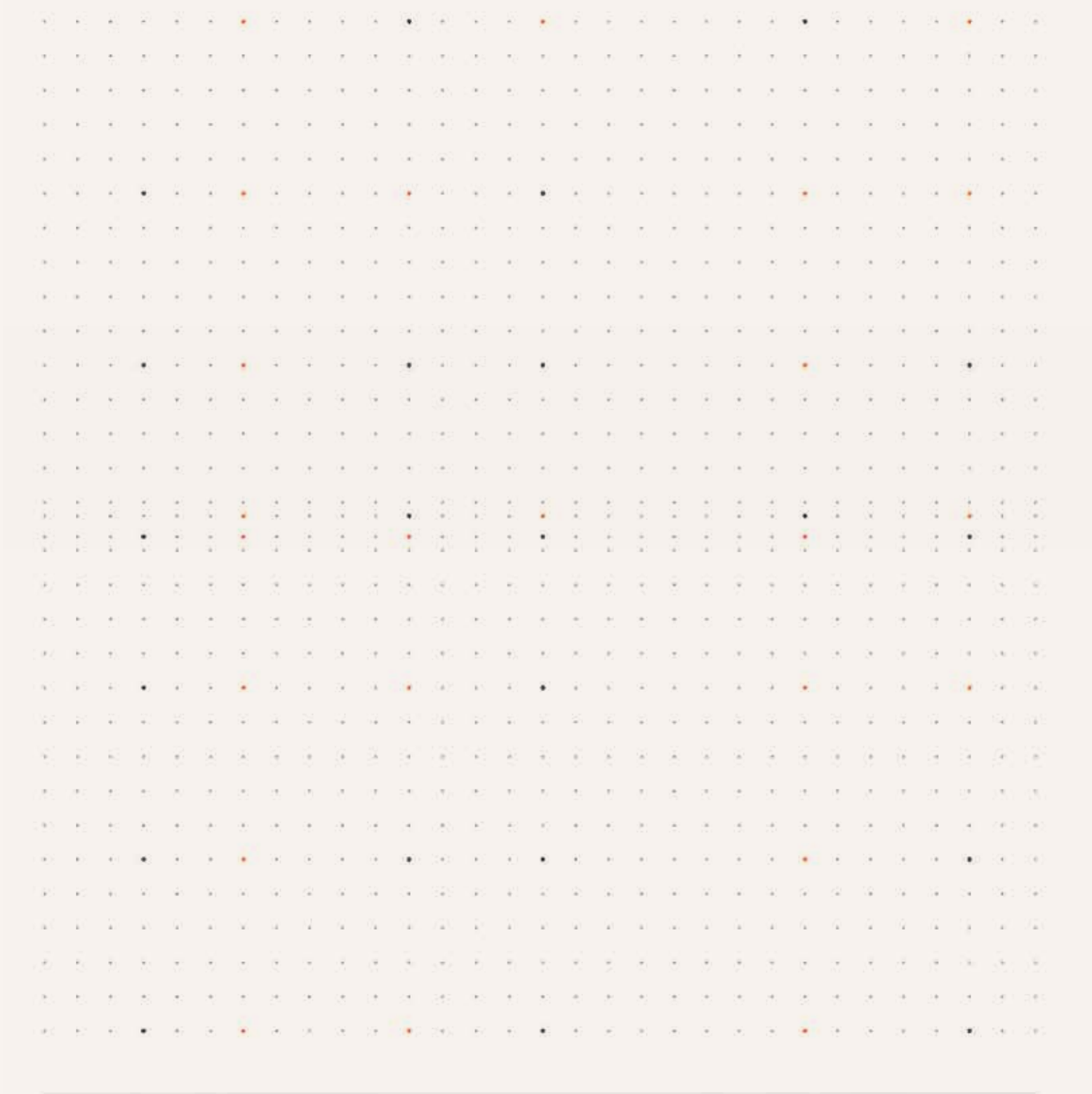

The 3rd B.V. Doshi Memorial Exhibition

Honouring a Living Legacy

The Ambuja Neotia Group recently unveiled the third edition of the B.V. Doshi Memorial Exhibition, continuing its annual tribute to India's first Pritzker Laureate, Balkrishna V. Doshi. Conceived to sustain the profound architectural dialogue championed by Doshi, the initiative honours practices that place people at the core of design and view built form as a vibrant setting for collective life. Some of whose works were exhibited in the past include architects Girish Doshi, Neelkanth Chhaya, Sohan Nilkanth & Kallol Joshi.

This year's showcase presented the extensive architectural journey of Ar. Madhusudhan Chalasani, Founder and Principal Architect of Studio MADE.

Studio MADE's Magic

Established in 2007 and operating between Hyderabad and Pamplona, Spain, Studio MADE is an idea-driven collaborative practice that engages with public architecture almost exclusively through international open competitions.

Working with a dedicated global network of architects, landscape designers, and researchers, the studio treats built and unbuilt schemes alike as rigorous instruments of inquiry rather than mere speculative proposals. The practice's international acclaim includes the award-winning Suncheon Art Platform in South Korea (honoured with the 2022 Korea Spatial Culture Award), alongside accolades from the Holcim Foundation and the Chicago Athenaeum International Architecture Awards.



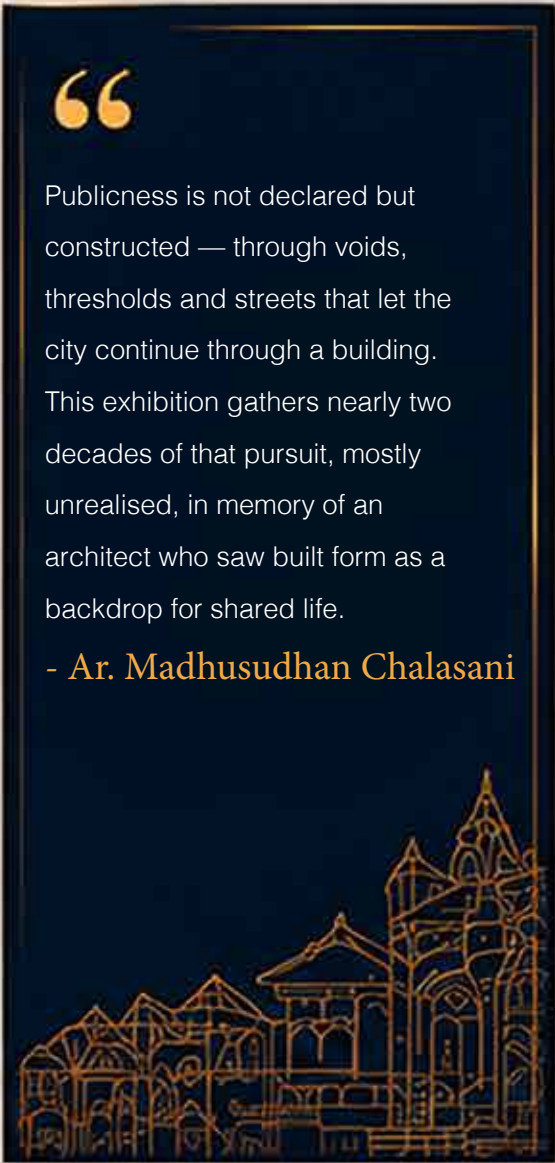

Framing the Public Realm

Titled *In Pursuit of Publicness*, the exhibition explored nearly two decades of spatial inquiry into how architecture can choreograph shared urban experiences without rigid prescription. Through detailed models, drawings, and contextual research, the curation challenged the notion of buildings as isolated monuments, highlighting voids, thresholds, and civic continuities.

Elaborating on the core philosophy behind the showcase, Ar. Madhusudhan Chalasani shared: “Publicness is not declared but constructed — through voids, thresholds and streets that let the city continue through a building. This exhibition gathers nearly two decades of that pursuit, mostly unrealised, in memory of an architect who saw built form as a backdrop for shared life.”

Reflecting on the platform’s vision, Harshavardhan Neotia, Chairman, Ambuja Neotia Group, noted: “The B.V. Doshi Memorial Exhibition was conceived not simply to remember an extraordinary architect, but to continue the conversations that he inspired. Through this year’s exhibition and the Prabir Mitra Memorial Award, we celebrate architecture that places people at its centre, engages thoughtfully with the public realm, and contributes meaningfully to society.”



The exhibits unfolded across three curatorial lenses

The Non-Building: Schemes designed to occupy their contexts lightly, achieving maximum spatial impact through minimal structural intervention.

The Mediator: Works acting as thresholds that negotiate transitions between urban dualities—such as city and park, or museum and landscape—without erasing their distinct boundaries.

The Void and the Periphery: Projects that pull the built form to the edges, returning expansive, shared voids back to the city.



Prabir Mitra Memorial Award

Alongside the exhibition, the inaugural evening witnessed the presentation of the 2nd Prabir Mitra Memorial Award to Kolkata-based architect Udit Mittal. Instituted in memory of the late Architect Prabir Mitra — celebrating his enduring wisdom, humility, and dedication to design integrity — the honour recognizes the Most Promising Architect whose emerging body of work demonstrates design excellence, responsible practice, and a meaningful contribution to the contemporary built environment.

Founder and Principal Architect of Kolkata's QX Design, Udit Mittal is widely recognised for championing climate-responsive, sustainable architecture rooted in craftsmanship, indigenous materials, and innovative bamboo engineering. Expressing gratitude on receiving the award, Mittal termed the transition from sitting in the audience last year to being honoured on stage as “surreal and overwhelming.” Remembering B.V. Doshi as a “perpetual Guruji,” he urged young practitioners to treat sustainability as second nature and design with genuine compassion: “Avoid overthinking what constitutes the ‘perfect’ style. As Martin Scorsese said, ‘the most creative is the most personal’ — lean into personal authenticity rather than chasing trends.”

The programme provided 150 boys and girls with protein supplements and dry ration kits to help address dietary deficiencies and support overall child health.



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Under its ongoing Nutrition Programme, Neotia Bhagirathi Woman and Child Care Centre partnered with Swasamman Welfare Foundation to organise a nutritional support drive at Ramkrishna Sarada Kalpotaru Sebadham in Sarisha. The joint initiative provided 136 children with protein supplements and ration kits to improve daily nutritional intake.

With the support of Durbar, a General Health Camp was recently conducted at Sobhabazar, benefiting 140 women from the local community. The outreach camp provided free clinical consultations, routine health check-ups, and complimentary prescribed medicines, alongside distributions of sanitary napkins and intimate hygiene washes.

The minimally invasive procedure effectively corrected the defect, enabling her discharge the following day in stable condition under the encouragement of visiting Rotary members.

Supported by Rotary Club of Calcutta Mahanagar and Adventz Finance Private Limited, 11-year-old Srijit Bachar underwent a successful total cardiac correction—involving VSD closure and the placement of a Contegra conduit—after presenting with severe cyanosis from a complex heart defect. Following a smooth ICU recovery, he was discharged in good health on the fifth postoperative day, warmly received by representatives from the Rotary team.



Supported by Shyam Metalics, six-month-old Pritika Adhikari—born with single ventricle physiology and pulmonary atresia—successfully underwent a complex bifurcation stenting procedure across the ductus and left pulmonary artery to address severe arterial stenosis. The clinical intervention resolved her critical desaturation, ensuring a smooth postoperative recovery and safe discharge.



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Neotia Bhagirathi Woman and Child Care Centre, Guwahati, recently partnered with Lions District 322G to roll out an exclusive health check-up initiative for its members under the leadership of Manoj Bhajanka. The drive was introduced to extend quality preventive healthcare and clinical screenings to the Lions fraternity and the wider community.

Neotia Bhagirathi Woman and Child Care Centre, Guwahati, recently hosted a Parenting & Child Health Seminar on the hospital premises.
