Bimla Devi Poddar – affectionately known as Barima – was a gracious presence and a deeply revered figure whose life embodied the essence of service, devotion, and cultural guardianship. She left us on the night of May 14, 2025, at her residence in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, on the sacred banks of the Ganga.

With a heavy heart and heartfelt reverence, we humbly pay our tribute to this distinguished philanthropist, social worker, and cultural preservationist, who was also the matriarchal spirit behind the Poddar Neotia family. Her departure marks a significant loss to the entire Ambuja Neotia Parivaar, and the nation, as she was a tireless advocate for India's rich cultural heritage and spiritual legacy.

A guiding light to all who had the privilege of knowing her, Bimla Poddar dedicated her life to the service of society and the preservation of Indian culture. She was the visionary founder of Jnana-Pravaha, a Varanasi-based centre for cultural studies established to safeguard and promote India's ancient traditions, art, and history. Under her stewardship as Managing Trustee, Jnana-Pravaha became a beacon of cultural exploration, housing a remarkable heritage museum with artefacts from ancient India and a distinguished library, including the rare and priceless collection of Late Suresh Neotia. Her efforts ensured that the institute remained a vital resource for scholars, artists, and enthusiasts of Indian heritage.

Bimla Poddar's life was intertwined with both cultural and entrepreneurial spheres. Married to the late Bimal Kumar Poddar, she was part of a prominent business family and played a key role in directing the family enterprises towards a successful growth path. Her business acumen complemented her philanthropic endeavours, enabling her to channel resources into meaningful cultural and social initiatives.

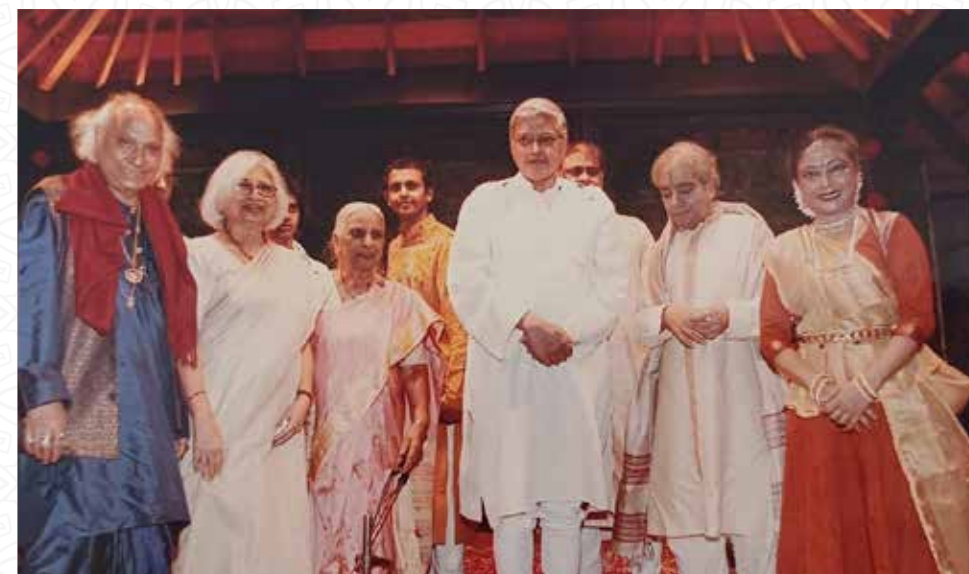

Expert Health Tips for Keeping Cool

Dr. Somenath Gorain, Consultant, Paediatric & Neonatal Critical Care, Neotia Bhagirathi Woman and Child Care Centre, New Town, shares essential advice for parents to ensure their children remain cool, safe, and happy during the warmer months. By following a few simple steps and recognizing early signs of heat-related issues, families can enjoy the summer safely.



Steps to Take

- Maintain Hydration: Offer water frequently. If needed, provide ORS (Oral Rehydration Solution).
- Light, Hydrating Meals: Encourage the consumption of fruits like watermelon and cucumber, and coconut water.
- Appropriate Clothing: Dress children in loose-fitting cotton clothes.
- Sun Protection: Apply broad-spectrum sunscreen and utilize physical sun protective measures (like hats and shaded areas) when outdoors.
- Cooling Methods: Use fans or cool showers to help prevent heatstroke.

Steps to Avoid

- Outdoor Play During Peak Heat: Do not allow children to play outdoors between 12 PM and 4 PM.
- Sugary and Carbonated Drinks: Avoid giving children carbonated or sugary beverages.
- Poorly Ventilated Spaces: Ensure children are not in closed spaces without proper ventilation.

Recognizing Early Signs of Heat Exhaustion

Be vigilant for early signs such as fatigue, dizziness, nausea, or clammy skin.

Seek Medical Help: If these symptoms persist, consult a medical professional immediately.



Special Considerations for Infants and New-borns

- Continue Breastfeeding: Ensure frequent breastfeeding to maintain hydration.
- Monitor Urine Output: Keep an eye on the baby's urine to assess hydration levels.
- Avoid Excessive Wrapping: Do not over-bundle infants to prevent hyperthermia.
- Dehydration Fever Management: Dehydration fever is not uncommon in new-borns. It can be managed with frequent feeding, sponging, and maintaining a normal environmental temperature.

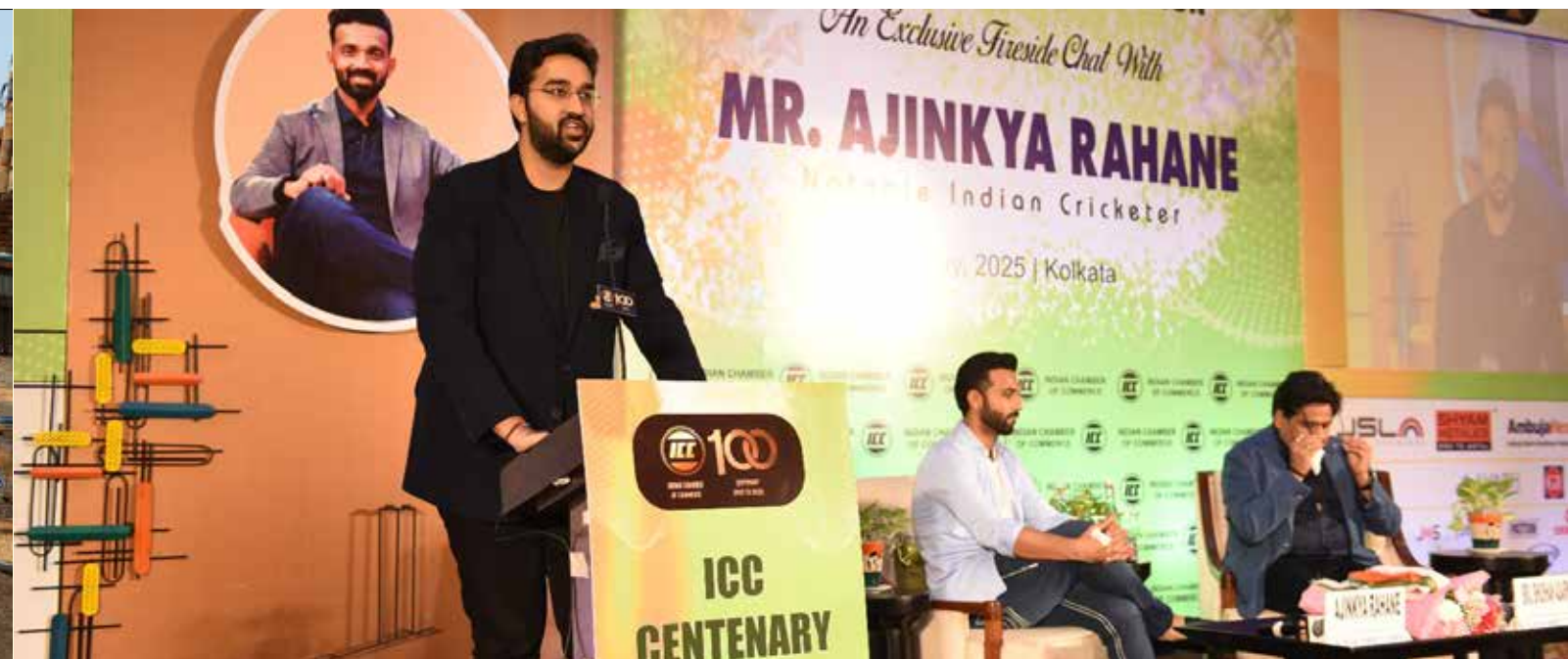

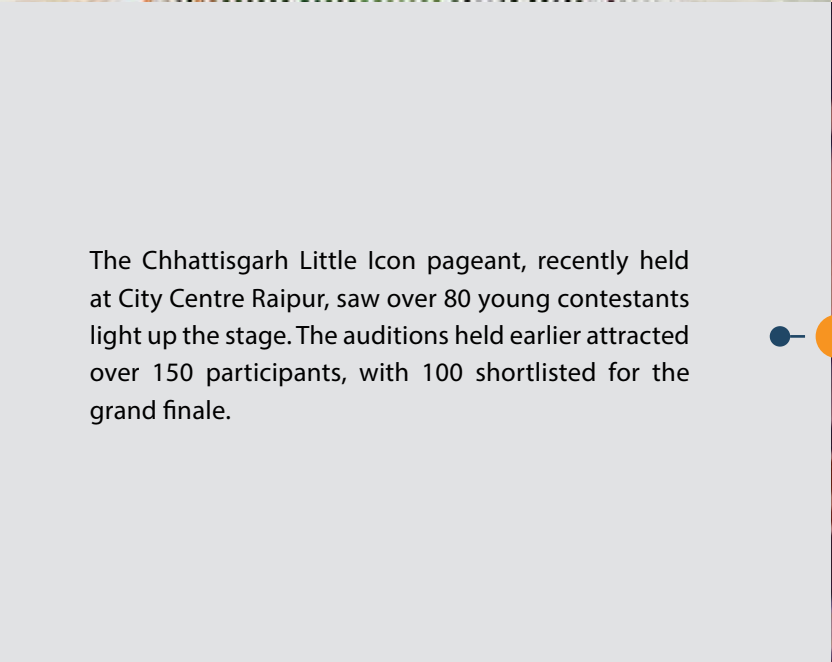

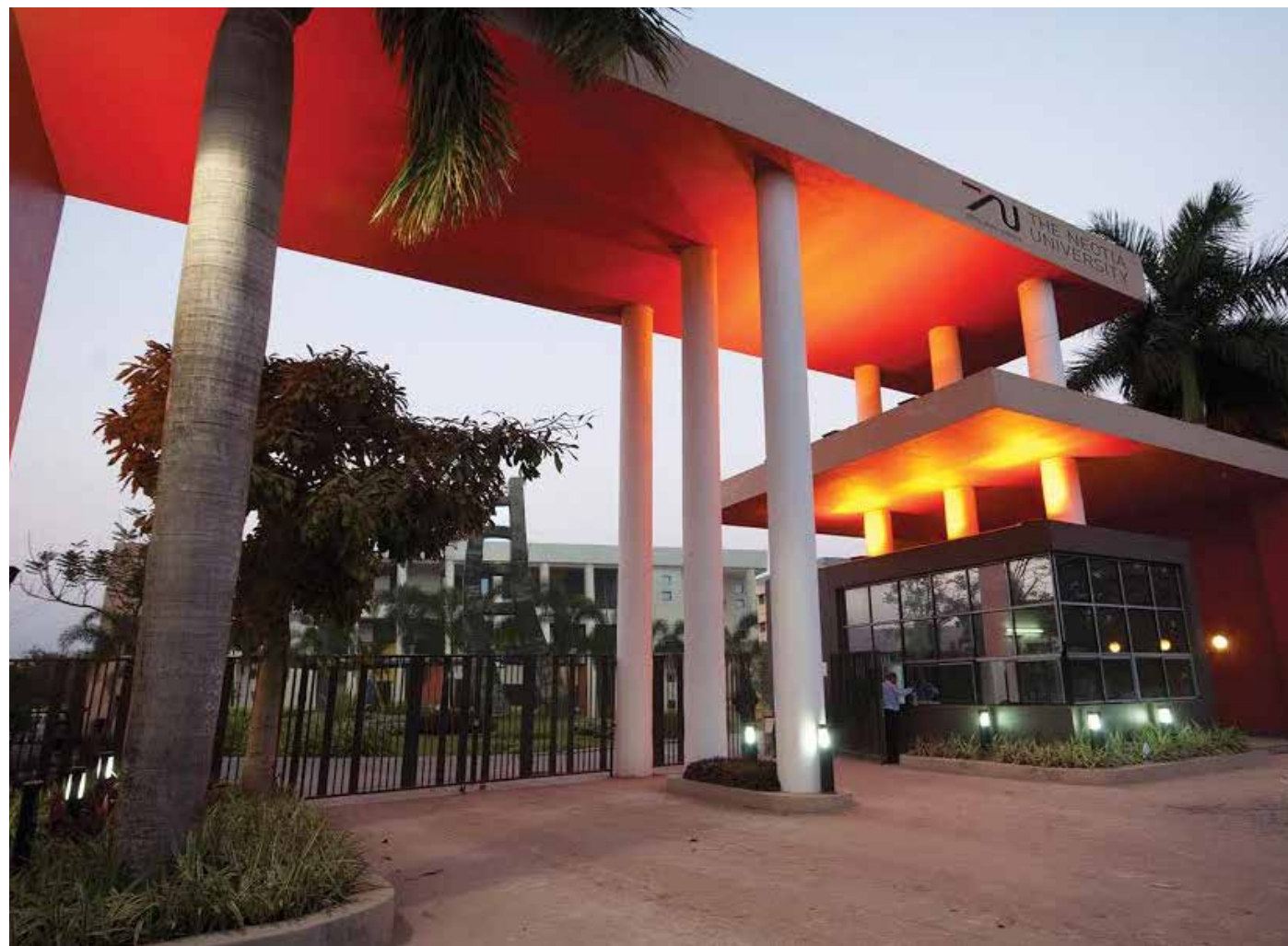
